

#### **Report Working Group**

- > Inventory centrally managed reports and dashboards
  - Determine those to retire or update
- > Deliver initial standardized core financial reports
- MicroStrategy Reporting Subject Areas:
  - Finance
  - Human Resources
  - Procurement

- ➤ Financial Activity Under Chart P
  - FY 23 and future activity
  - Converted historical data
  - Updated and New Reporting

#### MicroStrategy Chart P Reporting

- > Historical Data conversion
  - Supports Trend Reporting
  - 5 years of Chart 1 activity cross-walked to Chart P
  - FY 18 to FY 22 & Grant history
- > Subject Areas with Historical Conversion:
  - Finance Transactions (O&E and GL)
  - Labor Detail
  - Position Position Org
  - Purchase Order
  - Invoice/Check

#### MicroStrategy Chart P Reporting

- > Report Consolidation
  - Streamline reporting by eliminating redundant reporting
  - Report Mapping
    - Administrative Project report to new Chart P report
- > Shared Reports
  - Prioritized with input from Reporting Working Group and users
  - Metrics:
    - o Number of Users
    - o Report Execution counts
- Department Reports
  - After Shared, common reports
  - Broadly used reports will transition to shared folders


#### **Reporting Standardization**

- > Filter Changes:
  - Chart 1: Account between 61000 and 89999
  - Chart P: Account L1 = Expense
- > Removing Custom Grouping:
  - Chart 1: Account Groups 1, 2, and 3, Fund Groups
  - Chart P: Account L1, L2 and L3, Fund L2

- Benefits:
  - Keeps filters up to date as the chart changes over time
  - Ensures consistent answers across reporting

#### **MicroStrategy Dossiers**


- Dossiers
  - Organize reporting content into Chapters and Pages
  - Interactive display for exploring data
